WHAT: Sheriff's Office Seeks Public Assistance in Identifying Attempted Kidnapping Suspects

NARRATIVE: DOUGLAS COUNTY, CO -- On Friday February 9th, 2007, at approximately 4:05 P.M. Deputies from the Douglas County Sheriff's Office responded to the area of Cottonwood, which is located in unincorporated Parker Colorado. Deputies learned that two 10-year-old boys, while walking home from the bus stop were contacted by an unknown white male.

One of the victims saw a black 4 door SUV (unknown type) parked. The SUV had three white male occupants in the vehicle. A white male exited the vehicle. The subject was wearing a black ski mask and started to walk towards the boys. The subject tried to talk to them and the boys took off running.

The victims were able to run to a nearby house, where they received help in calling 911.

The Douglas County Sheriff's Office immediately released a metro wide bulletin to surrounding Law Enforcement agencies regarding the incident, which included suspect and vehicle descriptions. Deputies also checked surrounding areas for the suspects and their vehicle, however were unsuccessful.

One of the suspects was described as a white male, approximately 18 to 20 years old, wearing a black ski mask, grey shirt, and jeans.
