



Douglas County Citizen Disaster Preparedness Training

Following a large-scale disaster, community members may be asked to shelter in place for a period of time if deemed safer for them to stay put instead of evacuating. This can be due to a disaster with an extensive impact and expansive size, loss of communication, impassable roadways, and extremely limited emergency response capability.

The Douglas County Office of Emergency Management is pleased to offer this training to the citizens of Douglas County. The Citizen Disaster Preparedness Training utilizes the national Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) training curriculum and augments this with practicums throughout the training, culminating in a final disaster simulation. This training has been developed to teach basic organization skills that will help you help yourself, your loved ones, and your neighbors during a disaster.

The course curriculum will cover the following topics:

- ✓ Emergency Medical Operations
- ✓ Stop the Bleed
- ✓ Light Search & Rescue Operations
