- 1. Never send money to people you haven't met in person.

- 4. Never send money for an emergency situation without verifying that it's a real emergency.
- 5. Just because you can withdraw money for a check you received and deposited, doesn't mean the check is good. It can take weeks for a check to bounce.
- 6. Never send a money transfer for online purchases.
